





4. Colorful Campus Life



STEAM STUDIES

The curriculum integrates experimental inquiry, STEM projects, and digital learning tools, with the goal of cultivating students' critical thinking and problem-solving abilities. Supported by advanced laboratory facilities, teachers adopt inquiry-based teaching methods and actively encourage students to take part in a wide range of science competitions in Hong Kong and beyond.

Collaboration with universities and technology enterprises further broadens our students' exposure, enabling them to gain valuable experiences across diverse scientific fields. We also organize a variety of workshops that stimulate innovative thinking and inspire students to apply knowledge in creative ways. Interdisciplinary teaching connects science, mathematics, and technology, equipping students with the skills and mindset necessary for further studies and future careers.

At the same time, we are committed to the professional development of our teachers, ensuring that our teaching remains up to date with the latest advances. Through these efforts, the school has established itself as a leader in science and STEAM education in Hong Kong.

INNOSPACE

INNOSPACE is designed as a dynamic hub where imagination, technology, and collaboration converge. It is divided into three innovative zones, each providing unique opportunities for students to experiment, explore, and excel.

- Cyber Hub A modern computer center that houses both a campus television station and an e-sports arena. This zone blends recreation with purposeful learning, enabling students to develop practical skills in digital media production, competitive gaming strategies, and cutting-edge technology.
- InnoLab A advanced innovation laboratory where students engage with land-based robotics, drones, and underwater robots. By applying hands-on programming and engineering design, they deepen their understanding of artificial intelligence and robotics while cultivating problem-solving skills and an inventive mindset. The lab encourages experimentation and perseverance, qualities essential for future innovators and engineers.
- STEAM Cave An immersive learning environment featuring a Cave Automatic Virtual Environment (CAVE), which allows students to step into simulated worlds and explore complex, interdisciplinary concepts. Adjacent to the Cave, the Idea Lounge provides a welcoming space for English oral lessons and informal chatting with our Native English-speaking Teacher. It offers students a relaxed environment to build fluency, confidence, and cultural awareness while enjoying authentic language practice beyond the classroom.









LANGUAGE EDUCATION

English Language

We cultivate confident communicators and critical thinkers through engaging and interactive learning. Our experienced teachers employ diverse methods, such as project-based learning, public speaking activities, and cross-curricular collaboration, to connect classroom lessons with realworld applications. To foster a lifelong love of English, we offer a tailored junior literature curriculum and structured reading programs. Beyond academics, students refine their skills through English Society events, drama productions, and language competitions, helping to build a vibrant culture of expression and growth.





Chinese Language

We strengthen language mastery, literary appreciation, and cultural understanding through a rich blend of textual analysis, guided writing practice, and curated readings that expose students to both classical and contemporary works. By engaging with Chinese Language, Putonghua, and Literature, students not only sharpen their communication skills but also cultivate habits of critical thinking, aesthetic sensitivity, and ethical reflection that shape their outlook on life. To deepen learning, enrichment opportunities such as book clubs, cultural excursions, and interschool competitions create lively contexts for students to explore language in action. These experiences spark curiosity, inspire creativity, and nurture a genuine passion for the beauty and power of language.

ACADEMIC RESULTS AND UNIVERSITY OFFERS

Our students attained strong results in the HKDSE examinations. Over the past three years, an average of **93%** met the basic entrance requirements for university admission, with each student obtaining on average **2.2** subjects at Level 5 or above.

During the same period, an average of 92% of our graduates received JUPAS degree offers, with 43% of these coming from the University of Hong Kong, the Chinese University of Hong Kong, and the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology.

Beyond Hong Kong, our students also secured admission to leading international institutions, including the University of Oxford, the University of the Arts London, and Peking University.



In the 2025 HKDSE examinations, one of our students attained seven Level 5**, earning recognition as one of Hong Kong's "super top scorers". Such an accomplishment not only reflects the student's diligence and perseverance, but also affirms the school's commitment to academic excellence.

2. Peer Support & Friendship Building

Our **Student Counsellor Scheme** pairs Form 1 students with supportive seniors who offer guidance, answer questions, and help newcomers adjust both academically and socially. Through the **F1 Activity Day**, students bond with classmates and teachers in a fun, interactive setting, fostering friendships and a sense of belonging.

3. Balanced Class Placement

Form 1 students are placed in classes with **mixed academic abilities**, ensuring no class is stereotyped as "stronger" or "weaker". This approach encourages collaboration, mutual support, and a positive learning atmosphere for all.


